

Hello Citizen Scientists,

Warmer weather is upon us, Hooray! Your tomato seedlings should be ready for transplanting soon, wait till night temperatures consistently stay above 7-10 °C. If you plant a bit early and notice low night temperatures, cover your plants with a piece of cloth or plastic to help protect them from the cold. If you haven't already got your snow peas and beets in the ground, it's time to get sowing!

This is a friendly reminder to add your planting and transplanting dates (if applicable) in SeedLinked. To add your planting dates navigate to 'track' then select any of the trials then click on the dark grey 'dates' button.



Also, don't forget to rate the germination. Rating is a mixture of judging the varieties independently and comparatively. If all of your seeds germinated, 5 stars are merited, if none of your seeds germinated 1 star would be appropriate, however, it's really up to your judgement.

If you want to step into scientists shoes, calculate the germination percentage by dividing the number of seeds germinated by the number of seeds planted, and feel free drop the percentage in the rating reason or comments. Calculating a percentage can help you figure out an appropriate rating.
