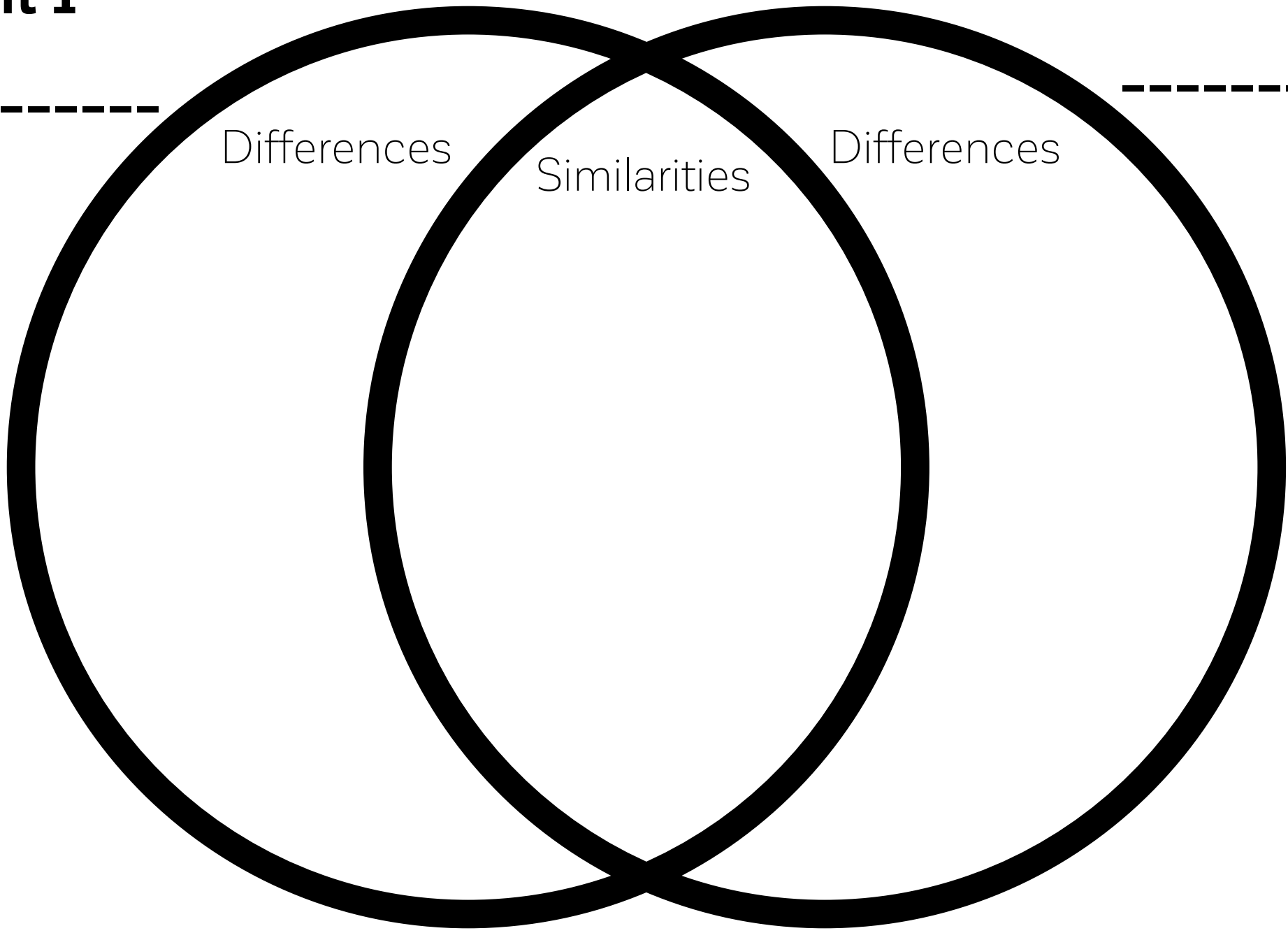
- is self pollinating, doesn't require pollinators to reproduce
