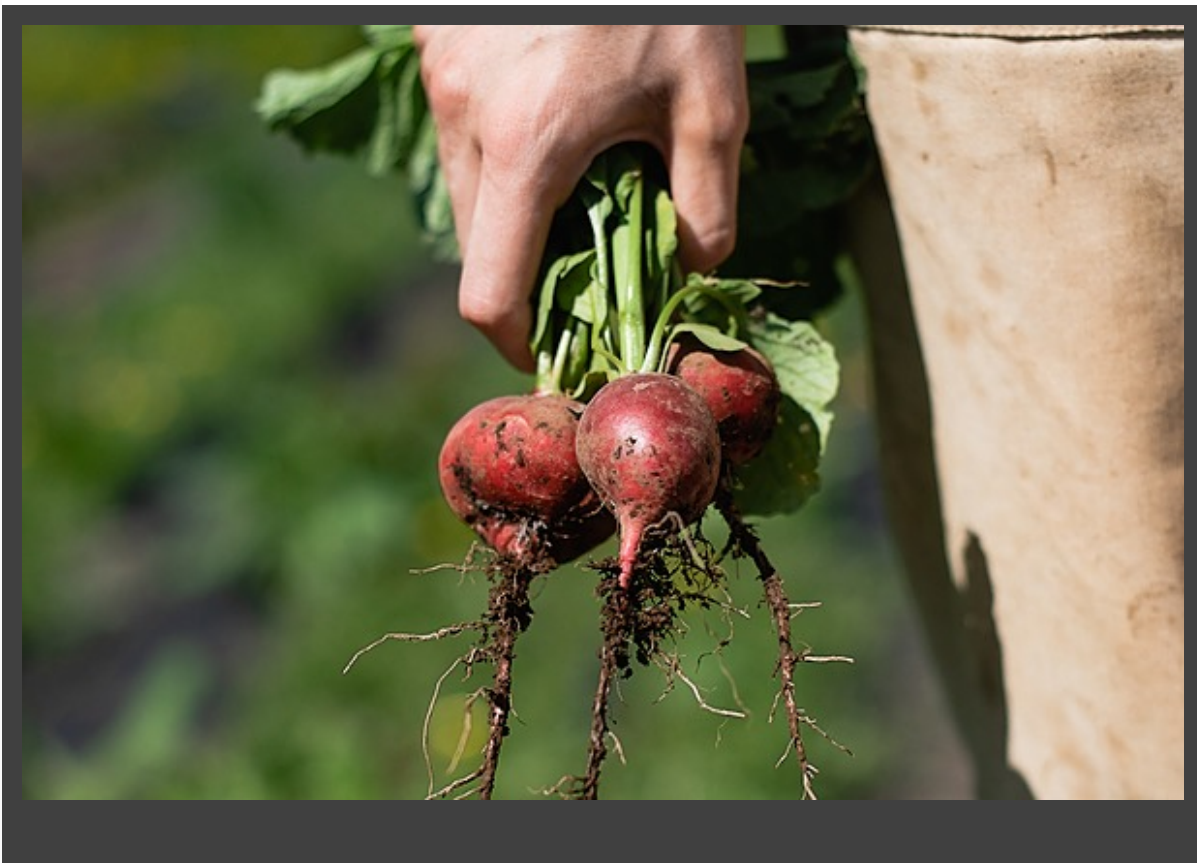




Dear Citizen Scientists,

We hope everyone is enjoying their first couple weeks of summer! This is a friendly reminder to enter your data into [SeedLinked](#). As this year's theme was early season crops, many of you should be enjoying your harvest by now and some may have even completed the trial. If you're having troubles evaluating your crops, check out our [evaluation rubrics](#). This is a great time of year to enter your harvest dates, and evaluate yield and flavour.

If there has been mishaps in the garden this year, no worries! Please press the 'Complete Trial' button even if you have not evaluated everything. We understand that there are many obstacles in gardening that can prevent us from harvesting a crop or sometimes we are not able to record our data in SeedLinked however it really helps us out if you click that 'Complete Trial' button once you've finished entering all the data you plan to enter.



At our [Research and Education Seed Farm](#) we have harvested all of the radishes, and most of the salad turnips (there's still some of the white egg left to harvest).
The pea harvest is still going strong.

The last day to enter Citizen Seed Trial data on SeedLinked will be August 11th, but don't worry we will send you a couple reminders. Save the date for our final Citizen Seed Trial webinar coming up on August 17 from 4-5 pm.
